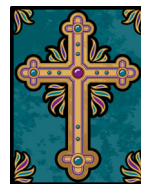

## THE HAITIAN SITUATION

Please pray for the people of Haiti and for a generous response from the church and the world community.... Our contact with the Episcopal Diocese of Haiti has informed us that Trinity Cathedral, the diocesan complex and the Bishop's residence have been completely destroyed.

...Our ministry leadership team, led by Dave and Deacon Anita, are working to establish contact. They will begin making assessments of the needs of St. Marie Madeleine and the community of Bondeau and how we can most effectively respond to those needs,, as information becomes available.

...Bishop Frade is requesting that funds can be sent directly to Episcopal Charities, our diocesan arm for disaster relief. Checks can be made to "Episcopal Charities of Southeast Florida" and sent to the diocesan office: 525 N.E. 15th St., Miami, FL 33131. Alternately, checks can be made out to St. Gregory's Episcopal Church and marked in the memo line "Haiti Relief" to be directed to our partners in Bondeau.
