CLERGY: (The clergy shall bless the cross.) Bless, O Lord, this cross and grant to your servant now to be admitted to this Order such abundance of your grace, that she may wear this sacred symbol in the spirit of humility and with devotion to the service of the King of Kings. Amen.

(Taking her by the right hand, the clergy receives the candidate and the cross of the Order is given to the candidate by the clergy.)

CLERGY: I receive and admit you into membership of the Order in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Accept and wear faithfully this mark of your membership, remembering the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, "Take up your cross and follow me."

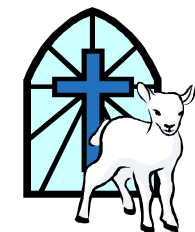
