The Healing and Music Ministry:

Healing Prayers, the laying-on-of-hands, music, spiritual direction, and anointing are the vessels in this ministry for God's loving healing and restorative touch in our lives. This ministry is available to those seeking restoration, spiritual guidance for healing/restoration, and/or healing, as well as those in transition and their family and friends. The Healing and Music Ministry is available to the St. Gregory's congregation, shut-ins, Nursing Home or Rehabilitation Center residents, Hospital or Hospice Care patients, or upon request.

The people presenting themselves to the healing and music ministry come from a variety of points in their lives; each person has different and yet equally valid needs or desires from the Healing and Music Ministry. All of the tools available to the Healing and Music Ministry are available to each person in any combination or separately. Every person will reach out to the Healing and Music Ministry for what they are led to, or are comfortable with.

The mission of the Healing and Music Ministry is to meet each person at the intersection of their Challenge Point and God's Space. The Challenge Point is that place where a person identifies their needs, rationally views their crisis, and faces their challenges. God's Space is where the person identifies and finds God, and where the Holy Spirit and the Word of God are Present and active.

Healing Prayers & laying-on-of-hands at St. Gregory's during Holy Communion:

The Healing and Music ministry is available while the Holy Communion is being administered. To receive the laying-on-of-hands, healing prayers, and anointing go to the Altar Rail and receive your Holy Communion, then go directly to the Healing and Music Team; the ministry is available during Holy Communion.

Schedule of Masses offered at St. Gregory's:

1. Sunday Services at 8AM, 10AM, and 6PM during Holy Communion.
8AM & 10AM: Receive Holy Communion then go directly to the Chapel for prayers.
6PM: Receive Holy Communion then go directly to the main Sanctuary for prayers.
2. Every Thursday at Noon
3. All Feasts, Holy Days, and Other Days
4. At various facilities in the community (i.e. Boca Raton Rehabilitation Center)
5. Or as requested in individual sessions

OSL Prayer Group:

Meets at 9:30 for one hour on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays to investigate prayer; share; and pray and worship. Open to entire congregation and the community.
